| Smart Packing at Rating

Cartonization consists of arranging the products to find the best package size and configuration to maximize space and reduce shipping costs. The difference between a shipment that randomly places small items into large boxes versus strategically packing a number of items into the smallest available box can result in huge financial gains at scale and over time.

ShipHawk's cartonization algorithm, Smart Packing, makes the packing process more efficient and accurate, reducing shipping costs and material waste. With the Smart Packing process, human error and timely calculations are removed from the equation, allowing for resources to be spent on other activities.

While Smart Packing helps you optimize the actual packing process, even before the packing takes place, ShipHawk applies the Smart Packing optimizations to the rating process, taking them into account when you offer your customer the in-cart shipping cost. As a best-in-class solution, ShipHawk offers real-time rates based on the packing materials available at each warehouse before your customer has even purchased the product.

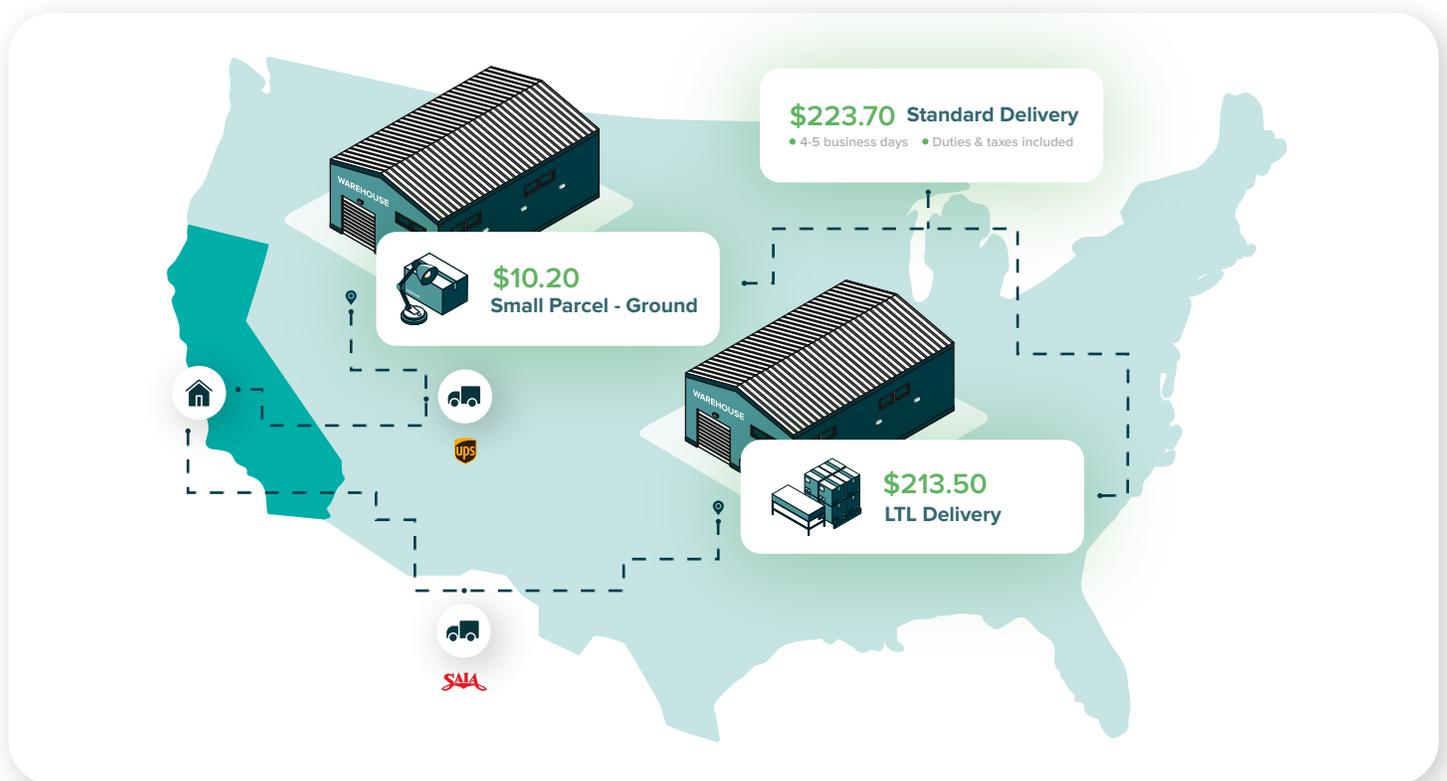
Without this ability, customers may end up paying less than the actual shipping cost, resulting in losses for your business. On the other hand, a customer may be deterred by high shipping costs that reflect inaccurate packing and are in reality much less than displayed at checkout.



Multi-Modal Rating

Packing optimization doesn't just end at small orders. Using multi-modal rating, ShipHawk can find the most efficient way to pack items between Parcel and Less-than-Truckload (LTL) pallets. Taking into consideration factors such as weight, availability of packing materials and how fast the shipping needs to be, ShipHawk can perform this same Smart Packing process on demand to determine if an order should be palletized or packed in small parcels.

This process can also rate mixed products together, combining LTL and parcel for one order if needed. For example, if a customer orders a large couch and a small lamp from the same website, the optimal packing solution for the order could include a pallet for the couch and a small box for the lamp. While other warehousing and fulfillment solutions may offer rating for LTL or parcel individually, they do not provide accurate rating results when it comes to multi-modal shipping directly in-cart like ShipHawk can.



Multi-Origin Rating

Multi-origin rating is another best-in-class tool available from ShipHawk that determines the best warehouse to ship from by looking at inventory and distance. For example: let's say an order comes in for two different SKUs. Unfortunately, of your three warehouses, the closest warehouse to the customer doesn't have both products. With ShipHawk's multi-origin rating, as a business, you can choose to have the warehouse that is the closest send the item they do have and then have another warehouse send the remaining item, or have them shipped all together from the fewest, but possibly farther origins to avoid shipping multiple boxes.

When inventory information is available at rating, ShipHawk can take into account both proximity to the customer and availability within the warehouse, automatically providing the optimal shipping cost in your customer's shopping cart.

Further, you can easily create customized rules to manage all kinds of unique fulfillment scenarios based on your business requirements. One of these functions allows you to input priority for warehouses if desired. For example, if it is the holiday season and sales are increasing. You can change the default shipping origin to be the largest warehouse with more inventory to avoid backorders and delayed shipments. Additionally, if natural disasters or special events cause one warehouse's operations to cease, the priority can then be rerouted to the next closest warehouse location to the customer. Like packing optimization and multi-modal rating, this process is done at rating, providing on-demand information about inventory and optimal warehouse origin to help compute accurate shipping quotes.
